#### **Ordinance Information:**

§ 123.03 LICENSING OF THE OPERATION OF RENTAL MULTIPLE DWELLINGS AND DWELLING UNITS, ROOMING HOUSES AND ROOMING UNITS, AND RESIDENTIAL ASSOCIATION RENTAL DWELLING UNITS.

(A)No person, corporate or business entity, condominium, townhouse or homeowners' association shall operate a rental dwelling or dwelling unit, rooming house or rooming unit, or a residential town home or condominium association unless a valid rental/residential association operating license, referred to as an RRA license has been issued by the director of finance for the specific location, and a special use permit if required.

(3) Residential Association: No associations that control and are responsible for the exterior, interior and/or common areas of residential multiple-family properties shall do so unless a current RRA license has been issued by the director of finance for the specific location. A current list of individual rental dwelling unit owners within the property shall be provided to the director of finance by the association, including the name and address of the person in control of each rental location. The name, address, phone number and e-mail address of the management company and agent representing the association shall be provided.

### Association License Inspection

Association common areas and properties are required to be maintained safely and in good repair. The exterior property is inspected by the Village systematically and any interior common areas are inspected annually. Please contact the Community Development Department at 847.923.3700 with any inspection questions.

# **Crime-Free Housing Seminar**

All persons applying for a rental license shall have successfully completed a mandatory crime-free multi-housing seminar, administered by the Schaumburg Police Department, prior to issuance of the rental license. Please contact the Crime Free Hotline at 847.348.7274 with questions about the class. This seminar is recommended for Associations and not required.

#### **Rental License Inspection**

As owner of a rental property, you are responsible for maintaining the property and unit. The heating system shall be cleaned and inspected by a licensed HVAC contractor each year. There shall be working smoke detectors inside each bedroom, outside bedrooms, and on each floor. Working carbon monoxide detectors are required. Electrical outlets shall be GFCI protected as required. Although it is not required, an interior rental inspection should be conducted in the near future. It is in the best interest of the property owner and tenant to ensure the property is maintained and meets minimum code requirements relating to life safety issues.
