Schaumburg Police Arrest Man for Attempted Murder

Schaumburg, IL — On February 08, 2024 at 08:20 PM, the Schaumburg Police responded to a parking lot in the area of 1200 Cambia Drive for a neighbor complaint. While the responding officer investigated the 911 call, the officer heard multiple gunshots in the area. Officers located victims and witnesses who identified the shots came from a balcony. The victims identified the shooter, due to their previous interactions with him from living in the same neighborhood. The shooter, Jacob Tamillo, retreated into his apartment and was not cooperative with officers' multiple requests for him to exit his apartment. The Northern Illinois Police Alarm System (NIPAS) responded to the scene and Tamillo surrendered. He was taken into Schaumburg Police custody at approximately 12:45 AM on February 09, 2024. The weapon, a black handgun, and spent shell casings were recovered from the scene. There were no injuries or damage to property as a result to this incident.

Schaumburg detectives completed a thorough investigation of the case. After reviewing all the facts of the investigation, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved 2 counts of Attempted Murder/Intent to kill/Injure, against Jacob Tamillo who will appear in the Circuit Court of Cook County today, 26th and California, Chicago, for a detention hearing.

Charge: 2 Counts 720ILCS 5/8-4(a)(720-5/9-1(a)(1)
